The unique presentation has become an Easter tradition for thousands throughout the region. The 2020 season promises to bring a mix of new-and-old looks to the stage that will speak to a broad range of audience members.

Tetélestai will be presented free-of-charge throughout Ohio over the two months that lead up to Holy Week. The production relies on its interdenominational all-volunteer cast and crew of over 110 members in order to stage the production and to fulfill its mission of spreading the Good News through a theatrical medium.
